The Experience of Discovery



- I blame and judge others when they don't meet my expectations
- I hesitate to express my feelings, for fear of being too "emotional"
- I "go-along" rather than face conflict, tension or uncomfortable conversations head on

What to Expect

In case you haven't already noticed, *Digging Deep* is not your average leadership development program! It is a unique learning experience designed to deepen your understanding of who you are and how you might bring more of YOU into the world.

It is an experience rooted in personal reflection, deep listening and community building. There will be no need for compulsive note taking, no bombardment of information, and no assessment of your personality or leadership skills based on an external test!

Instead... you will be thoughtfully guided by an experienced leader using a blend of facilitation, coaching and mentoring techniques. Our learning will co-evolve based on the diversity of our experiences and the unique alchemy of the group. During our sessions we will draw from creative practices that are well-tested and widely recognized to support selfdiscovery, including collaborative learning, mindfulness and storytelling.

The *Digging Deep* experience is held over 8 Zoom video sessions, each 2 hours long. Sessions are scheduled on a bi-weekly basis to allow time for meaningful reflection and integration of learning. You will receive challenges and assignments in between sessions to further your leadership discoveries.

Digging Deep is a highly interactive, group learning experience – your full attention and participation at each session will be required! To ensure the best conditions for learning and growth, group size is capped at 12 participants. Digging Deep is open to all individuals who self-identify as a woman working in construction.

- An expanded sense of and appreciation for the unique leadership capabilities you possess
- ◆ Deeper connection to and trust in your inner wisdom
- More confidence; the kind that comes from being in and belonging to a community of like-hearted women
